

Code of Conduct

The transgression of these points will not directly result in harsh punishment. They are merely there for the member to recognise what TSEA Link does (not) tolerate with regards to behaviour.

1. Speak English when in the presence of international members. Use English in chats that have international members.
2. Be respectful towards each other. Opinions or jokes that knowingly hurt someone's feelings are not welcome in Link.
3. Any form of bullying, personal attacks, racism, sexism, discrimination, or anything similar will not be tolerated.
4. If you want to start a discussion about a sensitive subject, provide a trigger warning beforehand, and ask yourself if this is the right place or time to discuss this.
5. We do not tolerate any form of inappropriate behaviour during Link events. Keep personal feuds to yourselves, be respectful towards the organisers and hosts of events and drink responsibly.
6. Do not glorify the usage of drugs or illegal substances on any official Link platforms.
7. Do not share explicit content in the Link communication platforms (eg: Official Whatsapp chats, Discord etc),- unless this is a link towards content that provides context to a discussion. When doing so, provide a content warning.
8. Do **NOT** share any invite links to Link communication platforms (eg: Official Whatsapp chats, Discord etc) to non-Link members
9. Do not promote personal events on official Link platforms that take place at the same time and date as an official Link event, unless properly communicated and agreed upon with the organisers of that event.
10. Sending the same or similar message over and over again will be regarded as spam and will not be tolerated
